

Invoices/Billing

- Family Day Home educators set their own fees. Educators receive all of the fee they are charging families.
- The Affordability Grant is provided to families if they have children not yet attending grade 1. This is based on the child's hours of enrollment in the Day Home and reduces the parent portion of the child care bill.
- Some families may see a 3% fee increase on the child care bill, and then that same 3% is being given back . To families who get the Affordability Grant, the government said they will cover the 3% increase. This is only for children not yet attending Grade 1.

Please note that many of the changes you've seen since late 2022 are because Children's Services has different rules that come out that Agencies and Family Day Home educators need to follow.


Weather Changes
